## Praying for the Christian book trade

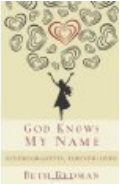
The third national **Day of Prayer for Christian Retailing** is scheduled for Friday 3 September.

Here at the Eastbourne Christian Resource Centre we are planning to once again hold our own prayer time in the shop on that day.

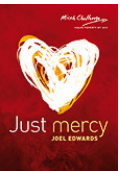
We will meet from 5.15pm to 6.30pm, and all church leaders, friends, and supporters are welcome to join us.

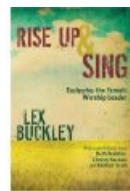


*Just Mercy* by Joel Edwards (£4.99)

## New Music News

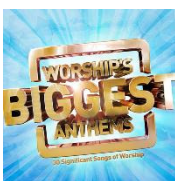

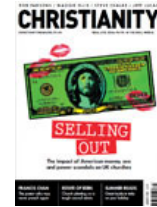
